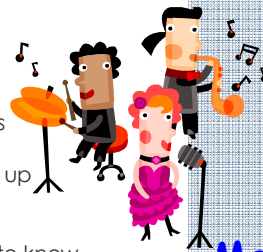
## Monarch Talent Show \* March 11th

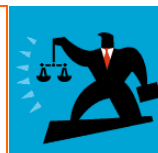
