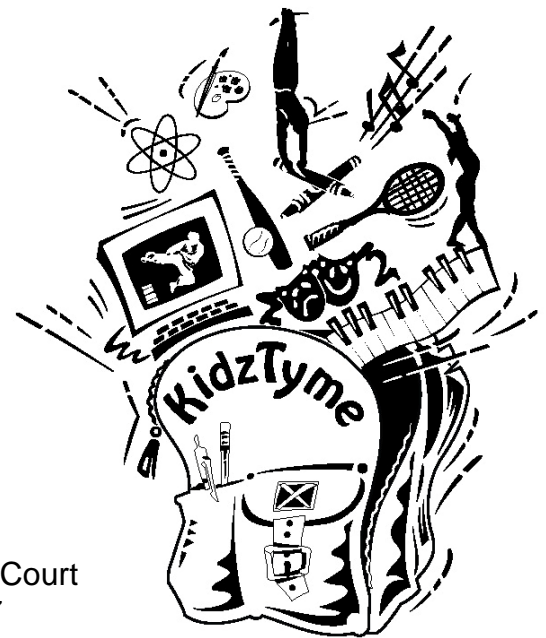

Class Descriptions



BASKETBALL Grades K-5 The basketball program is for aspiring young players. Games, contests, and drills will be used to help young players develop their skills such as passing, dribbling, shooting, rebounding, and defending while learning how to work within the framework of a team. Students of all skill levels are welcome. The instructor has been coaching basketball for many years and enjoys sharing the passion for the sport with young students.



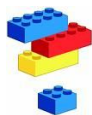
CLAY Grades K-5 This is a hand-building course using slab, coil and pinch methods. Projects include functional pieces such as mugs, bowls, banks; and sculpture pieces might include castles or animals. Pieces are both bisque and glaze fired. Pride and self-satisfaction are the byproducts of this class. Students may want to bring an old paint shirt to keep their clothes clean. A professional potter will instruct this class. New and returning students are welcome. Returning students will be challenged with new projects.



DRAWING – WONDERS OF THE RAINFOREST Grades K-5 The rainforest will come to life as we create vibrant artwork inspired by nature's landscape. Learn fascinating facts along with Monart drawing technique and an exploration of various media such as watercolor, colored pencils, oil pastels, markers, chalk and much more. We will explore using different media such as watercolor, colored pencils, oil pastels, chalk, mixed media, and much more. The Monart drawing program is an innovative, step-by-step drawing method that can teach all children how to draw – regardless of artistic ability. Students will gain skills to express their creativity that will last a lifetime. All materials will be provided. Brand new subject matter will be introduced every week. Monart's philosophy is to give children a positive, nurturing environment as they teach fundamental drawing techniques. You will see increased ability, self-confidence and self-esteem. In this guided drawing class students will experience the magic and joy of artistic expression in a comfortable and non-competitive environment. HIP HOP AEROBICS Grades K-5 Do you want to learn the latest dance moves like the ones you see on, "So you think you can dance?" Then Hip-Hop aerobics is the class for you! This class will consist of a fun and aerobic stretch, dance games, creative movement and each week the class will learn part of a routine which will be performed for family and friends on the last day of class. This is a high energy class that guarantees a cardio workout, a positive and safe environment and a whole lot of fun learning the latest hip-hop moves! The instructor for this class is a former Chargers' cheerleader and is certified by the National Academy of Sports Medicine. She enjoys teaching children dance and fitness.



LEGO® Jr. Engineering Grades 1-4 Using LEGO® Educational Division Materials and LEGO® Technic elements students will learn by doing. Working with a partner, students will cooperatively build and modify machines exhibiting basic engineering principles. Course uses industrial machines to cover the concepts of gears and gear ratios, simple machines, structures, forces in motion and more. Students may outgrow their love of LEGOs (don't count on it), but concepts learned in this class will stay with them forever.



MANDARIN Grades K-5 Students will be introduced to Mandarin Chinese. Mandarin is the official teaching language of China. The goal of this class is to build a solid Chinese phonetic foundation. This program has been designed to be fun and highly interactive. Materials include games, songs, stories, poems, role-playing, and drama. Students will gain pronunciation skills, learn simple Chinese words and everyday greetings. While studying the language, students will learn about the fascinating culture and history of China. The YAK Academy will provide the instruction for this class. Students will be divided according to age and ability level.



MUSICAL THEATRE WORKSHOP – “MARY POPPINS!” Grades 2-5 Calling all performers!! Share the magic of Broadway musicals in this introductory program. Students will become familiar with the art of musical theatre and develop skills in stage movement/dance, vocal production for speaking/singing on stage, character development, and the creative rehearsal process. These skills will be applied in a workshop production of “MARY POPPINS!” Our goal is to provide a foundation for future performers and to increase self confidence, self awareness, and creativity of our students, both individually and as part of a team. Students are expected to attend **all** classes listed on the schedule to avoid disruption in the production process. On the last day of this session, there will be a performance for family and friends. The instructor for this class has many years of teaching children’s theatre.



READING S.T.A.R.S. Grades K-2 Reading STARS (Sensory Training Approach to Reading and Spelling) is a program developed by speech-language pathologists to enhance the early reading and spelling skills of typically developing children in grades K-2nd. The curriculum is designed to develop children’s awareness of sounds and letters through multi-sensory channels. Children can expect fun, interactive games and activities! We will be reading and writing stories, playing outside games, singing songs, and creating art projects that will enhance reading, spelling, and writing skills. Through participation in this unique course, students are intrinsically motivated to read and will express enthusiasm to continue learning. The class has a 1:5 teacher to child ratio so children get the individual support and attention they need. A fun, non-threatening classroom environment is created to encourage learning through discovery. Returning students welcome! SOCCER Grades K-5 The United Kingdom Soccer Academy offers a unique program. Each session concentrates on the fundamentals of soccer, including passing, shooting, and dribbling. Each player will learn and understand the basic rules of soccer. Emphasis is placed on teamwork, group awareness, individuality, sportsmanship and FUN! All instructors are competitive licensed club coaches or former professional soccer players. The UKSA directors would like to let you know about class cancellations on rainy days. TENNIS Grades 1-5 Mike Rogers, a certified professional and member of the USPTA, has designed a course which will introduce the students to tennis. This proven course will teach the students efficient movements and allow them to play the game more effectively in the future. The rules, serve, forehand, backhand, volleys and the overhead smash will be covered. Classes will take place on the school’s blacktop using the volleyball courts and backboards. Racquets and balls are provided. Students should wear tennis shoes and comfortable clothing. New and returning students are welcome.

For the Safety of the Children... If a child is unfamiliar with the campus, parents should accompany their child or make arrangements to have someone direct their child to the proper location for the first meeting of a class. Supervision is provided only during class time. It is imperative that students are picked up immediately after a class. Parents are required to meet students at the class location and to sign them out. The school office closes at 4:00 p.m. and the office staff leaves at that time. Any parent who is more than five minutes late will be charged at the rate of \$1 per minute payable to the instructor at the time of pickup. The student will not be permitted to return to the program until the late fee is paid. The administration of this program is separate from the school and it would be appreciated if you did not phone the school with “reminder” requests. Thanks for your cooperation.

POLICIES

- ◆ All instructors are professionals in their respective fields and have been fingerprinted, have tuberculosis clearance, and are CPR/ First Aid-certified.
- ◆ Transportation is not provided for the program.
- ◆ Supply costs are included in class fee unless noted.
- ◆ Times, length of sessions and locations all vary for each class. Read descriptions carefully and mark your calendars to make sure your student attends.
- ◆ School rules apply. Good behavior is expected. If a disciplinary problem develops, the student will be dropped from the class and no refund will be made.
- ◆ Class sizes are limited. Generally there are 6 to 20 students per class. Fees vary with class size and supply costs.
- ◆ There is a \$25 charge for returned checks.
- ◆ If a refund is necessary, there is a \$15 processing fee.
- ◆ Late applications will be processed subject to a \$15 late fee and class availability.
